

# May God be Gracious to Us

## Psalm 67:1-7

### 1. His face will \_\_\_\_\_ on us

1 May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face shine upon us, 2 that your ways may be known on earth, your salvation among all nations.

If I say, “I will forget my complaint. I will put on a happy face and smile,” (Job 9:27 EHV)

Do everything *without complaining or arguing*, so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe. (Philippians 2:14-15)

When I smiled at them, they scarcely believed it; the light of my face was precious to them. (Job 29:24)

### 2. His ways will be \_\_\_\_\_ on Earth

Go and announce to them that the Kingdom of Heaven is near. (Matthew 10:7 NLT)

<sup>19</sup>Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. <sup>20</sup>Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” (Matthew 28:19-20 NLT)

### 3. Our primary mission is to tell people about the \_\_\_\_\_ of the coming Kingdom.

<sup>11</sup>Dear friends, I warn you as “temporary residents and foreigners” to keep away from worldly desires that wage war against your very souls. <sup>12</sup>Be careful to live properly among your unbelieving neighbors. Then even if they accuse you of doing wrong, they will see your honorable behavior, and they will give honor to God when he judges the world. (1 Peter 2:11-12 NLT)

Honor Christ and let him be the Lord of your life. Always be ready to give an answer when someone asks you about your hope. (1 Peter 3:15 CEV)

For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes. (Romans 1:16a NLT)
