## Servants of Love

<sup>5</sup> The apostles said to the Lord, “Show us how to increase our faith.”

<sup>6</sup> The Lord answered, “If you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mulberry tree, ‘May you be uprooted and be planted in the sea,’ and it would obey you!” <sup>7</sup> “When a servant comes in from plowing or taking care of sheep, does his master say, ‘Come in and eat with me?’ <sup>8</sup> No, he says, ‘Prepare my meal, put on your apron, and serve me while I eat. Then you can eat later.’ <sup>9</sup> And does the master thank the servant for doing what he was told to do? Of course not. <sup>10</sup> In the same way, when you obey me you should say, ‘We are unworthy servants who have simply done our duty.’ (Luke 17:5-10 NLT)

1. Keep a servant mindset \_\_\_\_\_.

Anyone who wants to serve me must follow me, because my servants must be where I am. And the Father will honor anyone who serves me. (John 12:26 NLT)

2. Serve \_\_\_\_\_ expected.

“For God is not unjust. He will not forget how hard you have worked for him and how you have shown your love to him by caring for other believers, as you still do.” (Hebrews 6:10 NLT)

3. Serve your \_\_\_\_\_ with love and duty.

Who is more important, the one who sits at the table or the one who serves? The one who sits at the table, of course. But not here! For I am among you as one who serves. (Luke 22:27 NLT)
