

## Part 5. Zechariah: The Burning Log, Robe and Turban

### Zechariah 3:1-7

1. Christians are the \_\_\_\_\_ snatched from the fire by Jesus.

For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23 NLT)

2. When you accept Jesus as your savior, you are imputed or covered with Christ's righteousness called a \_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>14</sup> “For many are called, but few are chosen.” (Matthew 22:11-14 NLT)

3. The \_\_\_\_\_ is God's declaration to the world that we are holy.

You shall also make a plate of pure gold and engrave on it, like the engravings of a signet, ‘Holy to the Lord.’ You shall fasten it on the front of the turban with a blue cord. (Exodus 28:36-37 AMP)
