

Mark: The Gospel of the Ox



Mark in the New Testament was a secretary for the Apostle Peter and wrote down his version of the gospel emphasizing Jesus as the *suffering servant* for humanity. In his culture, the Ox was the emblem of servanthood and one of the four faces of the Seraphim throne guards.
