

## Mark Part 8: Being Poured into So You can Pour Out

<sup>32</sup> That evening **after sunset**, many sick and demon-possessed people were brought to Jesus. <sup>33</sup> The whole town gathered at the door to watch. <sup>34</sup> So Jesus **healed many** people who were sick with various diseases, and he **cast out many** demons. But because the demons knew who he was, he did not allow them to speak. <sup>35</sup> **Before daybreak** the next morning, Jesus got up and went out to an **isolated place to pray**.
