¹⁸ And as He was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed was begging Him that he might accompany Him. ¹⁹ And He did not let him, but He said to him, “**Go home to your people** and report to them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He had mercy on you.” ²⁰ And he went away and began to **proclaim** in Decapolis what **great things Jesus had done for him**; and everyone was amazed. (Mark 5:18-20 NASB)
