1. Rejection is the _____ of speaking the truth with love.

For we speak as **messengers approved** by God to be entrusted with the **Good News**. Our purpose is to please God, not people. He alone examines the motives of our hearts. (1 Thess. 2:4 NLT)

2. God's work in people's lives is _____ by unbelief.

6 But when you ask God for something, you must trust him completely. Do not have other ideas in your mind. People who are not sure that God will help them are like the waves in the sea. The wind blows the water one way and then it blows the water another way. 7-8 A person who is like that never knows what to do. He has many ideas in his mind. He should not think that he will receive anything from the Lord. (James 1:6-8 EASY)

3. Jesus did not let _____ stop him.

11 Yes, happy are you when people say bad things against you because you believe in me. Or they may hurt you. Or they may say things about you that are not true.

12 God is preparing many good things for you in heaven. So you should be very happy when people do these bad things to any of you. People did these same things to God's prophets who lived long ago.' (Matthew 5:11-12 EASY)

4. Jesus _____ at Jewish unbelief and Gentile faith.

9 When Jesus heard this message from the officer, he was very surprised. He turned towards the crowd that was following him. He said to them, 'I tell you, I have not found anyone like this man in all of Israel. Nobody else believes in me as well as he does.' (Luke 7:9 EASY)
